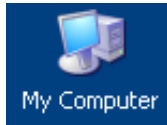


Installing the Marsden History Group Photographic Archive

The CD needs to be inserted in your computer's CD drive, printed face up.



To 'find' the CD on your computer, you need to go into the **My Computer** icon (usually on your desktop — double-click the icon to open it) and then pick your CD drive.

The drive will be named with a letter (for example, D) and, if you have the Marsden Photographic Archive CD inserted in your computer, it will also be named 'Marsden Archive'. Double click this to open the CD.

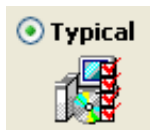


Once you have the CD open on your computer, you need to double-click the folder called **Setup Files**.

Inside the folder you will see a number of files. Double click on **setup** and this will launch the program that installs the Archive on to your computer.



Follow the instructions onscreen. When you come to the **Licence Agreement** page, you need to click on the button that says you agree to the licence. This simply means that you agree not to make and distribute copies of the CD, and that the copyright of the CD belongs to the Marsden History Group. Once you have clicked that you agree to this, you can then click on the 'next' button.



Next, you will be given the option how you want to use the CD. Picking the **Typical** option means that, once installed, you do not need the actual CD to be inserted in your computer to use the Archive.

However, this option takes up about 400mb of space on your computer. If you do not have much spare room on your computer, then you can choose the **Minimal** option. By installing the 'Minimal' option, you will need to insert the CD every time you use the Archive but it will only take up a small amount of space on your computer.



If you receive an error message such as 'Cannot install File.dfl, this file may be in use or locked', this simply means that a file the programme is trying to update on your system is already on your computer. Simply click OK to continue; this message will have no effect on the installation or the running of the software.

If you chose the 'Typical' installation, it may take a few minutes to copy all the files on to your computer.



Once completed, a camera icon will appear on your desktop. Double click this to start using the Archive!

If you chose the 'Minimal' option, you need to make sure the CD is inserted in your computer before double-clicking

For full instructions on using the Archive, choose **Using the Archive** once you have started the software.
